Father Frederick Akah MSP received word that his home town of over 3000 people was attacked by hired mercenaries in Nigeria. There is a war that is raging between two clans. His family home was destroyed. His sister and his brother-in-law's home were also destroyed and John, his brother-in-law was killed leaving his wife and 3 young adult children without a home or food. Father Frederick is asking for prayers for his family and village.
Our sympathies to Father Frederick and his family on the death of his brother-in-law John. May his soul and the souls of all the faithful departed, through the mercy of God, rest in peace.

The Final Report from the diocesan phase of the Synod is now available in English and French on our website at the Synod Page <https://www.padiocese.calsynod2023>.

The prayer and consultation that took place during this diocesan phase identified six main areas or priorities for our parishes and institutions. These were condensed in the conclusion of the report but are not limited to:

1. Ongoing opportunities for listening to each other to continue healing and reconciliation in our parishes as we become more a Church that journeys together, particularly, with our Indigenous brothers and sisters.
2. Ongoing opportunities for learning how to listen to the voice of the Holy Spirit as parishes and the diocese discern the path forward at this time. Continuation of the synodal journey that has begun.
3. Initiatives that will teach us how - with trust in the Holy Spirit - to accompany others where they are at on their faith journey especially those who feel separated or marginalized in our communities and schools.
4. Greater emphasis on outreach to those in our parishes who need support and those in need in our communities both local and global.
5. Ongoing faith formation for all age groups focused on kerygmatic catechesis, which includes opportunities for encountering Christ.
6. Ongoing formation for clergy and parish leadership to aid in the implementation of these initiatives in areas such as liturgy, RCIA, the new *Directory for Catechesis*, accompaniment, evangelization, etc.
