### Palm Sunday - A

**A Vocation View:** Today's world is so filled with suffering, injustice, anger, depression and loneliness that it cries for people waving palm branches of hope and resurrection, proclaiming new life.

**Prayer:** For the faithful response of all men and women called to follow Christ and His passion more closely through a vocation to the priesthood or consecrated life, we pray to the Lord.

**Action:** WHAT IS A SISTER? A sister lives in a religious community that follows a constantly renewed tradition, patterned on the life and teaching of the founder of the community.
