A Vocation View: This is the World Day of Prayer of Vocations: "The harvest is great, but the labourers are few. Pray to the Lord of the harvest to send more labourers into the Harvest."

Prayer: For an increase in vocations to the priesthood, diaconate, and consecrated life, especially for our diocese, that God will raise up good shepherds in our midst, we pray to the Lord.
