**A Vocation View:** Blessed is he who comes in the name of the Lord. Blessed is she who gives her life in the name of the Lord. Blessed are they who live their united life in the name of the Lord.

**Prayer:** That in imitation of Christ who emptied Himself for our salvation, more men and women will share in His passion for souls through a vocation to the priesthood or consecrated life, we pray to the Lord.

**Action:** RELIGIOUS ORDERS are receiving younger members and those who are more educated than those of previous years. In 2011, the average age of women professing perpetual vows was 39, 4 years younger than those surveyed the previous year. This was the first-year men were included in the survey and the average age of those entering Religious Orders was 42. When the participants were asked at what age they first considered a religious vocation, the average age was 19.
