Vocation Corner

28th Sunday in Ordinary Time - B

A Vocation View: If we really believe in something, it does not seem to be a sacrifice to give up everything else to pursue that one dream. Jesus asks for total dedication, promising in return rewards that no one else can promise: "Go and sell everything you own...then come; follow me."

Prayer: That those chosen to leave all and follow Jesus more closely in the priesthood or consecrated life will respond with the wisdom and understanding given by the Holy Spirit, we pray to the Lord.

Action: Invited to leave everything to follow Christ, you, consecrated men and women, no longer define your life by family, by profession, or by earthly interest, and you choose the Lord as your only identifying mark. Thus you acquire a new family identity, *Homily of Pope John Paul II, Jubilee of Consecrated Life, February 2, 2000*
